Bunbury Music Festival Offers VIP Ticket Package, Confirms Headliner Announce Date

Cincinnati festival offers ultimate music experience – sales end Sunday, June 30, 2013

Cincinnati (February 15, 2013) – Bunbury Music Festival returns to Cincinnati's Sawyer Point and Yeatman's Cove on July 12-14, 2013, and has announced its VIP ticket package today. The festival has also confirmed that the 2013 headliners will be revealed on Tuesday, Feb. 19, 2013.

There are a very limited number of VIP tickets available for the 2013 event, and sales for these tickets will end on Sunday, June 30, 2013. Three-day ticket prices are \$295 and include the following:

BEE a Volunteer:

Bunbury Music Festival is now recruiting the best volunteers Greater Cincinnati has to offer. The three-day event transforms the banks of the Ohio River into a unique music and festival experience where participating volunteers can work in a number of different areas. There is no application fee, multiple shifts are available (morning, afternoon, evening) and opportunities include beverage sales, box office/gates, bullpen, clean team, greeters, information/lost and found, volunteer headquarters and team leaders. Regardless of when and where volunteers work, their role is critical to the success of the festival. Not all applicants are guaranteed selection.

There is no monetary compensation for a four-hour volunteer shift; however, volunteers will receive, at minimum, free admission into the festival (on days worked) and a free t-shirt. Candidates must be 18 years of age or older and a resident of Greater Cincinnati. Selected volunteers will need to arrive 30 minutes prior to their shift for orientation and will need to sign a waiver.
