Bunbury Music Festival (July 11-13) and the inaugural Buckle Up Music Festival (July 18-20) will once again transform downtown Cincinnati into a unique, weekend getaway offering two major festival experiences like no other.

Bunbury Music Festival (featuring Empire of the Sun, Fall Out Boy, Paramore, The Flaming Lips, among others) celebrates its third year in 2014 as alternative music festival and will feature 80 live performances across six stages throughout Sawyer Point and Yeatman's Cove. On the banks of the Ohio River, this three-day event will be an unforgettable and unique music festival experience.

Buckle Up Music Festival (featuring Alabama, Willie Nelson, Alison Krauss & Union Station featuring Jerry Douglas, The Band Perry, among others) is a new music event highlighting a large array of American music including country, folk, bluegrass, Americana, roots rock and more that will take place at Sawyer Point and Yeatman's Cove spanning across six stages and featuring upwards of 80 performers.

Each festival offers a craft beer village, great food selections from national and local restaurants including Maui Wowi Hawaiian Coffee and Smoothies, Gold Star Chili, Chipotle, Dippin' Dots, Island Noodles and much more. Also dispersed throughout the festivals are vendors selling merchandise, clothing apparel and jewelry.
